The aim of the activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Gaining knowledge about the industrial history of the city of Lodz - Getting to know the characteristic features of industrial architecture - An explanation of what a factory and a steam engine are - Searching for differences between the countryside and the city

Age group for the activity	7 - 9 years old

A. BEFORE OUT-OF-SCHOOL LEARNING ACTIVITY	
Educational tools	Educational board, multibook „The Great Adventure”, online quiz, presentation, educational film
Method, technique and strategies	Work in pairs, work in groups, work with an illustration
PRACTICE	Searching for differences between a village and a city based on a video and illustrations. Didactic game: “From the village or the city”
Introduction of the activity	Division of the illustration: urban and urban landscape
Development of the activity	Making drawings: „Village”, „City”, painting „Manufaktura”
Evaluation of the activity	Conversation with students

B. IN THE OUT-OF-SCHOOL LARNING ENVIRONMENT	
Educational tools	Workshops at the Central Museum of Textiles
Method, technique and strategies	Lecture, machine shows, educational film, visiting the museum and seeing the exhibits, watching the buildings from the outside
PRACTICE	Participation in art workshop

Introduction of the activity	Designing your own factory - making posters in groups (drawing with crayons on large cardboard boxes)
Development of the activity	Presentation of the work of individual groups
Evaluation of the activity	Solving puzzles prepared by the teacher

C. AFTER OUT OF SCHOOL LEARNING ACTIVITY	
Educational tools	Multimedia presentation, practical activities – consolidating the acquired knowledge
Method, technique and strategies	Cardboard boxes, division into groups, instructions for the task, colored papers, tapes, plasticine
PRACTICE	Planning work, creating a project – making a mock-up of the factory
Introduction of the activity	Making mock-ups of factories in groups
Development of the activity	Presentation of works, exhibition
Evaluation of the activity	Conversation with children
